

Typical Camping Checklist

Be Prepared!

- ✎ Class A Uniforms (shirt, neckerchief)
- ✎ Socks—(1 per day + 1 day extra)
- ✎ Underwear—(1 per day + 1 day extra)
- ✎ T-shirts & Jeans/Shorts—(1 per day + 1 day extra), including class B
- ✎ Extra shoes
- ✎ Headgear (optional)
- ✎ Sweatshirt or jacket
- ✎ Raingear
- ✎ CLEAN mess kit
- ✎ First Aid kit
- ✎ Sleeping gear (sleeping bag, sleeping pad, camp pillow)
- ✎ Daypack if hiking
- ✎ Flashlight with extra batteries
- ✎ 2 or 3-man tent Folding chair
- ✎ Mosquito repellent—NO AEROSOL CANS (weather dependent)
- ✎ Sunscreen—NO AEROSOL CANS (weather dependent)
- ✎ Canteen or water bottle
- ✎ Spending money + money for any merit badges supplies and books
- ✎ Soap (non-scented), toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo and comb
- ✎ Sleepwear
- ✎ Scout handbook, paper, pen/pencil, merit badge books
- ✎ Pocket Knife*

Be aware of weather conditions! For Fall and Winter camping, use layers and wool/synthetic fabrics. Bring clothing that is appropriate for the camping event. Sleeping bags should be rated for the right weather.

* No sheath knives allowed. You must have earned your totin' chip!
